## SOUTHERN BAPTIST NATIONAL AND STATE LEADERS

The Southern Baptist Convention is made up of over 43,000 churches, united by the Cooperative Program, seeking to reach the world with the gospel by working together. To carry out the mandates of the collective body, there are many entities with responsibilities for the whole group.

The national entities include the SBC Executive Committee, The International Mission Board (IMB), The North American Mission Board (NAMB), LifeWay Christian Resources, Women’s Missionary Union (WMU), GuideStone Financial Resources, Ethics and Religious Liberty Commission, and six SBC seminaries. There are also 42 state Baptist conventions and 1,200 regional associations.

The SBC holds an annual meeting in June of every year for church messengers to come together to worship, be refreshed by the preaching of the word, and to discuss denominational business.

1. First of all pray for our leaders to guard their hearts and stand firm in their faith in Jesus Christ, setting their minds on things above, to be people of prayer, dependent upon God. (See Prov. 4:23; John 15:5, 7-8; 1 Cor. 16:13; Col. 3:2)
2. Pray for wisdom as they lead, preach or teach; and pray that they keep a humble spirit when recognition comes. Pray for opportunities to boldly share Christ with non-believers. (See Ja. 1:5; 2 Tim. 4:2; 1 Pet. 5:2-4, 6; Col. 4:3)
3. Pray for a spirit of love among the leaders and that they work well together for the glory of God. Pray against the spirit of pride or ‘turfism.’ (See Ps. 34:2-3; John 13:34-35, 17:21-23; 1 Cor. 1:26-31)
