## WEEK OF PRAYER FOR THE NORTH AMERICAN MISSIONS

NAMB's more than 5,200 missionaries are telling His story in both predictable and unpredictable ways. God is using North American missionaries like Reggie Robbins to share the gospel with people like Marcus and Pam Linner.

Marcus was once a man with many skills, but packing a suitcase was the only one that was legal. He was a gang member and drug dealer. He robbed banks, and even killed, all to feed his addiction to money. His career got him and his family kicked out of every place they ever lived until eventually, they ended up on the streets of Atlanta. With a wife and four small children, the Linner's were desperate. They found more than a roof over their heads at Sanctuary Shelter. Marcus and his wife Pam found Christ. God used one missionary to make two more. Now the Linner's are Southern Baptist Mission Service Corps (MSC) missionaries. According to Marcus, this is what you get when you pray and give to the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering® (AAEO)—dealers becoming disciples.

The suggested week for Southern Baptist churches to observe the annual Week of Prayer for North American Missions is March 5-12, 2006. This year's theme is Tell His Story. Our missionaries rely on the prayer support of Southern Baptists, and are encouraged and empowered in their ministries through prayer. They are dedicated to sharing Christ and seeing people come to know Him and rely on Christians to pray fervently for the lost to hear the gospel and accept Christ as Savior.

As you pray for the work of our missionaries, pray also for this year's giving to AAEO. The goal is \$56 million, 100 percent of which goes to directly support missionaries and their ministries. This offering is essential to keeping and growing an incredible force of missionaries on the North American mission field.
