Chaplains are making a difference all across North America. They are meeting the needs of people in a variety of settings,

such as leading Bible studies and ministering to truckers in truck stops. An Army chaplain in Iraq ministered faithfully to his soldiers on a daily basis and led 176 of them to the Lord.

A Kansas state prison chaplain was born and raised in India where he was led to the Lord by an IMB missionary. He later moved to America and now offers hope and light to those in a dark place. For example, he led a young man to the Lord who had killed his own father. When that young man learned that he was forgiven by God, he was able to forgive himself.

## Chaplains' Motivation is to Share Christ

[Keith Travis, Director of Chaplaincy Evangelism at NAMB tells about being a chaplain.]

“Almost 28 years ago I became a US Army chaplain, and I still remember how excited I was. Through the years God has taken me on an incredible journey — making me feel at times like Abraham, wandering from place to place, yet keeping me aware of His hand on my work.

When asked, ‘Why did you put yourself and your family through this, particularly after 9/11?’ My answer is quick and clear — the American soldier, who is someone’s son or daughter, father, or mother — America’s finest!

I was at Ft. Bragg, NC, for about two and half years ministering to soldiers who were preparing to go to Iraq and Afghanistan. Almost every day, as one of my chaplains or I walked out on the tarmac with soldiers loading a plane to head out, we had the opportunity to share our faith in Jesus Christ. That was my motivation — to share Christ. And I believe that is the motivation of all 2,750 NAMB chaplains serving across North America and the world today.

Chaplains in hospitals, prisons, the military, and corporations, as well as I, have been asked, ‘Why did you leave the ministry?’ I say, ‘Leave the ministry? No, I stepped right into it!’ So when you see chaplains, wherever they may be serving, thank them for their service and pray that God would empower them to be strong and courageous in their ministry and witness”.

### How to Pray for Chaplains

1. Pray for chaplains to remember God’s words to Joshua, “Be strong and courageous” (Jos. 1:6, NASB), and His unchanging faithfulness to give obedient servants protection and success in their ministry. See Ps. 91, John 15:1-15
2. Pray for the families of chaplains, who are assigned to dangerous places, to have the peace that passes all understanding as they take their concerns to God. See Ps. 55:22, 61, 62:8, Phil. 4:6-7
3. Pray for more volunteer chaplains to be called out to serve in the variety of places where they are needed. Pray to the Lord of the Harvest to send out workers. See Matt. 9:37, Luke 10:2, John 4:35-38
