The Hawaii Pacific Baptist Convention (HPBC) is a family of 125 churches in Hawaii, American Samoa, Samoa, Guam, Saipan and Okinawa. Dr. Veryl Henderson, long-time missionary to Hawaii is the Executive Director-Treasurer.

Staff includes Deanna Aoki – WMU/Women's Ministries Director, Clyde Kakiuchi – Leadership Development and Church Growth Director, Sung Ho Kang – Church Planting and Missions Director, Sean Lathrop – New Generation Ministries Director, and Chris Woodall – Prayer and Evangelism Director.

There are seven associations but only three have Directors of Missions (DOM): Leon Baker at the Big Island Association, Don Reed at Honolulu-Windward Association, and James Ditty at Guam Baptist Association. Pray to the Lord of the harvest to call four more leaders.

The Puu Kahea Conference Center is owned and operated by HPBC and is a vital part of equipping Christians for ministry. MSC Missionaries Furman and Faye Toney manage the center.

The Hawaii Baptist Academy opened its doors to its first students in 1949 and is one of the prolific evangelism ministries in the convention. It is a college prep school in a Christian context. The majority of students from kindergarten through 12th grade are not Christians when they start. Dick Bento is the president.

How to Pray for the Hawaii Pacific Convention

4. Ask God to give each leader named above – wisdom, boldness, and enthusiasm for the work that they do. Let them know you are praying for them. (See Gal. 6:9-10; Eph. 6:18-19, 23-24; Col. 4:2-3)

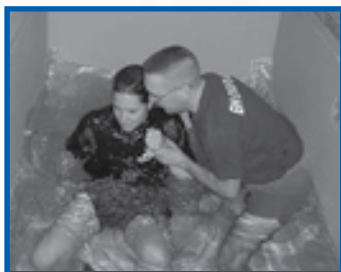
