WORLD CHANGERS AND POWERPLANT

John Bailey, Manager of Student Volunteer Mobilization

The Student Volunteer Mobilization Unit of the North American Mission Board offers pre-packaged mission opportunities for student through World Changers and PowerPlant.

For 15 years, World Changers has sought to meet needs by challenging Christian youth, college students, and their adult leaders to participate in hands-on mission experiences that will result in a changed world. Participants meet the physical and spiritual needs of others through construction and community service projects. At a project, participants are assigned to crews, which are made up of participants from several churches. Each crew has 10 to 14 participants. This dynamic allows students to meet and minister with students from other churches in North America. After a hard day of work and ministry at a project, participants come back to the lodging facility for some rest, to eat dinner, and to attend the evening worship service.

This year (2005) will be the third summer for PowerPlant, a new approach to student missions involving and educating participants in church planting and evangelism. At a PowerPlant project, ministry teams work alongside church planters in servant evangelism, sports camps, VBS, and other projects. A day at PowerPlant can be broken down into three segments: morning sessions on church planting and evangelism, afternoon on-site ministry, and evening large group gatherings. In the evenings, participants either come back to the lodging facility for a time of testimonies and worship, or on some nights could join together in the community for an event like a family festival or block party.
