

## Corporate Component

Reclaim the church as a house of prayer with a passion for lost people (see Mark 11:17; Luke 19:10).

- Develop a church prayer room ministry that focuses on evangelistic prayer needs.
- Challenge the congregation to make their homes lighthouses of prayer and outreach.
- Lead the church to be involved in regular prayer journey (walking) efforts (see Taking Prayer to the Streets).
- Participate in international prayer journey events.
- Participate in North American prayer journeys in Strategic Focus cities, associations, and yearly Crossover events in conjunction with the Southern Baptist Convention.
- Organize and participate in outreach prayer survey efforts.
- Begin a "prayer station" or "prayer booth" ministry in the inner city, at yard sales, carnivals, craft shows, flea markets, and during county and state fairs.
- Begin a midweek service that focuses on prayer for unbelievers, believers, and evangelistic mission efforts (see A House of Prayer).
- Develop men's, women's, senior adults, youth, and children's evangelistic prayer cell groups.
- Encourage "cottage" prayer meetings before revivals and evangelism efforts.
