Purpose, Guidelines, and Benefits of Utilizing the Mission Service Corps (MSC) Resource

Purpose:

Mission Service Corps (MSC) is a North American Mission Board resource that provides an endorsed missionary the opportunity to raise funds that his or her local sponsoring church voluntarily distributes for the mission and ministry of that missionary.

Guidelines:

- NAMB maintains discretion and control over all funds donated, and the Sponsoring Church maintains discretion and control over all funds they receive from NAMB.
- All donations given help support local ministry by partnering with local Sponsoring Churches.
- Missionaries are not NAMB volunteers or employees.
- Missionaries must be endorsed by NAMB and requested to serve in one of NAMB's approved categories.
- Missionaries are required to either work through a local church that will sponsor them, or set up their ministry's own 501c3.
- Any funds raised through the NAMB giving portal will be for and sent to the local Sponsoring Church or the missionary's 501c3.

Benefits:

- Online giving through NAMB's website for potential donors
- No administrative charge to process donations and receipts
- Ministry profile and "Give" button on NAMB's website
- Endorsement from NAMB as a missionary or chaplain
- Sponsoring Church that is committed to praying, participating and providing for the missionary
