# GOD'S DESIGN


The Bible tells us that in the beginning, God created everything, and He made it perfect. He **loved** Adam and Eve and put them in charge to take care of the world. God planned a friendship with the people He made and wanted them to enjoy everything. God only gave them one rule: Don't eat fruit from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.



## THE BIBLE SAYS:

*"God saw all that he had made, and it was very good indeed"  
(Genesis 1:31).*

*"The heavens declare the glory of God, and the expanse  
proclaims the work of his hands" (Psalm 19:1).*



# SIN


Adam and Eve disobeyed and broke God's one rule. They ate fruit from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, and they **ran away** from God. The world was not perfect anymore. When people disobey God, it's called sin. Sin separated Adam and Eve from God. They had to leave the garden and live in a broken world where they could get sick, hurt and would one day die. Sin is the cause of death.



## THE BIBLE SAYS:

*"They exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served what has been created instead of the Creator"*  
(Romans 1:25).

*"There is a way that seems right to a person, but its end is the way to death"* (Proverbs 14:12).



# BROKENNESS


Sin **broke** God's beautiful plan for us and separated us from God. We experience sin in our own lives, too, when we say and do selfish things that go against the Bible. We can't fix our sin problem by doing our best to be good, obey our parents, or go to church. These are all good, but there is only One who can forgive sin.



## THE BIBLE SAYS:

*"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God"*  
(Romans 3:23).

*"For the wages of sin is death..."* (Romans 6:23).



# CROSS


Jesus is the only One who can fix our sin problem. God made a way for us to be with Him forever. He sent Jesus, His only Son, to die on the **cross** and take the punishment for our sins. But that's not the end of the story — God raised Jesus back to life! And He offers us that same kind of forever life. He wants us to receive the forgiveness that Jesus provides.



## THE BIBLE SAYS:

*“He erased the certificate of debt ... and has taken it away by nailing it to the cross” (Colossians 2:14).*

*“Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures” (1 Corinthians 15:3-4).*




# TRUST & BELIEVE

How do we do that? We **pray** to confess our sins and ask Jesus to be in charge of our life. If we put our trust in Jesus, which involves admitting that we sin and need forgiveness, and if we believe that Jesus is God's Son who died on the cross for our sins and gives us new life, then we have decided to follow Jesus as our King!



## THE BIBLE SAYS:

*"For God loved the world in this way. He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16).*



# GROW & SHARE


By putting our trust in Jesus, we are now close to God and have a **friendship** with Him. We discover His plan by reading our Bible, praying, going to church, and asking other Christians to help us. Even when we sin and disobey, we know God will forgive us. And one day when we die, we'll live forever with God in Heaven. As a Christian, we also have a new job! We need to share the gospel with others. The gospel is the good news about Jesus and His forgiveness of our sins.



## THE BIBLE SAYS:

*"For it is God who is working in you, both to will and to work according to his good purpose" (Philippians 2:13).*

*"For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared ahead of time for us to do" (Ephesians 2:10).*



# WHAT SHOULD I DO?

Now that you have heard this good news, God wants you to respond to Him. You can talk to Him using words like these:

**Dear God, I need You. I believe Jesus came to live, die, and was raised from the dead to save me from my sin.**

**Dear God, please forgive me. I put my trust in Jesus. I know that He is Lord of all, and I will follow Him.**



## **THE BIBLE SAYS:**

*“If you confess with your mouth, ‘Jesus is Lord,’ and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved”  
(Romans 10:9).*

*“For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved”  
(Romans 10:13).*

# WHAT'S NEXT:

The Bible teaches how to start your new friendship with God. He desires us to have a relationship with Him and others. How?

**PRAY:** God wants you to talk to Him about everything.

**CHURCH:** The church is God's family to help you walk with Him.

**BIBLE:** The Bible reveals God's design — showing you how to live.

**SHARING:** Now that you have experienced this good news, tell others.



## THE BIBLE SAYS:

*“But these are written so that you may believe Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and by believing you may have life in his name” (John 20:31).*

*“But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be provided for you” (Matthew 6:33).*

*“So then, just as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, continue to walk in him” (Colossians 2:6).*
