

NAMB helps churches send missionaries, start new churches, and meet needs in the United States, Canada, and their territories. NAMB is part of the Southern Baptist Convention. Southern Baptist churches help people know and follow Jesus.



Church

A church is a group of people who worship God and serve Him together. They love and help each other as a family. Every follower of Jesus needs a church family. Millions of people live in North America. Many people live in places where there aren't enough churches. It's important to start (or "plant") churches everywhere so everyone can learn about Jesus.




Annie Armstrong Bible Church Gospel Jesus Missionary Missions Offering Prayer Serve


Many of their friends have become followers of Jesus and attend church together. Now, Vergil, his family, and their friends serve their neighborhood to share the good news about Jesus.




Mission Teach About Jesus Love



Noelson, his wife, and their children moved from the country of Haiti to the United States. The family visited Haitian churches in their new community, but the children did not always understand the language.




Color the pictures of children serving at church. In the blank circle, draw or write another way children can serve at church.

Chaplins Chapter People





Some church planters start new churches, but some planters restart churches. We call them "replanters." Replanters help a church grow and reach its community in new ways.


Alaska is a beautiful place to live. There are many mountains, trees, rivers, fish, and wildlife. The summer months may be warm, but the winter months are very cold and dark.

She also helps women learn how to make jewelry to sell so they can earn money to pay for food and a place to live.





The children's ministry grew from six children to more










Missionifies Serve Others

Matt and Amanda also started a summer camp for children. At the camp, children eat healthy meals, play games, and learn about Jesus and His love for them. There is also a wellness center that has a dentist and an eye doctor and helps with other needs.






The Kilgore family has a unique way to serve church planting missionaries. They know that starting a new church is not easy. They want to encourage and pray for






THE BIBLE SAYS:

"The heavens declare the glory of God, and the expanse proclaims the work of his hands" (Psalm 19:1).










THE BIBLE SAYS:

"There is a way that seems right to a person, but its end is the way to death" (Proverbs 14:12).








- "For the wages of sin is death ..." (Romans 6:23).







But that's not the end of the story—God raised Jesus back to life! And He offers us that same kind of forever life. He wants us to receive the forgiveness that Jesus provides.

"Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures" (1 Corinthians 15:3-4).





"For God loved the world in this way: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16).




CFOW CASING
