Discussion Guide:

• What do you think is an appropriate way for a church to be involved in politics? How should individual Christians be engaged in politics?

• Have you seen churches and Christians in your community put their politics above Christianity? How does this approach affect their witness within the community?

• How does political involvement of the church in America affect our Christian witness in other parts of the world?

• What are three ways you can promote unity within the church between believers with different political views?
